



Vision (Prayer) Activity

Use this activity to help students understand the importance of listening to God in prayer.

Understanding what God's vision is for your life is not always easy to discover. Some find it right away; others must search, pray, and fast. Make no mistake – God has a vision for you life -- whether on the surface or lying below it.

You will have 10 minutes to pray about the vision God has for your life.

Read Jeremiah 29:11-13

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

Now go through the passage again, but this time change the words to make it a personal prayer.

For example, *"God, you say that you know the plans for my life ... but I don't know them. Please show me. You say that they are good plans. What are they ...?"*

Facilitator:

After reading the introduction, allocate 10 minutes of uninterrupted time for prayer. Ask participants to take this time seriously and to make it a sacred experience. After 10 minutes, participants should write down something God has revealed to them. Everyone should write down something, even though it may change later.
